

#### What makes us different?

**Tradition:** we are the more experienced private university in Barcelona, having trained jurists from 1973 with excellent results.

**Methodology:** our teaching model is based on practical and personalised training through the resolution of real cases taken from professional offices, as well as attending to actual trials in the Provincial Court.

Internationalisation: thanks to our specialised bilingual programme in International and European Law Practice, as well as our partnership with the University of Saint Thomas (Minnesota) that allows for studying the LL.M. in US Law in favourable conditions, a degree given in this American centre.

Specialisation programme in the USA: the Programme CEU - The University of Chicago is an initiative for Law + Political Science students. It includes the possibility of taking a semester in Graham School of Continuing Liberal and Professional Studies.

**Supplementary training:** in order to boost the legal and technological training, offered by Wolkers Kluwer Certifica. Students will enhance their training, develop their knowledge and skills on this field, and their abilities in management, oratory and networking.

**Employability:** 90% of our students find a job at the end of their studies, 4 percentage points above the Catalan universities average. (Job Placement Survey AQU 2014)

**Complete Study plan:** thanks to the master's degree in Law, which gives students additional and professional training required by law. Last year, 100% of graduates in this master's degree passed the State exam that grants access to work as a lawyer.

**Double degree:** we have a pioneering methodology that allows for combining two degrees in five years: the double degree in Advertising and Public Relations + Journalism, and the double degree in Journalism + Political Science – bilingual.

Internationalisation: with bilingual degrees in Journalism and double degrees in Journalism + Political Science, as well as Advertising and Public Relations + Journalism. What is more, it is possible to stay abroad in the best universities in Europe, America and Australia.

**Innovation:** with our new bachelor's degree in Experiential and Virtual Communication\*, which trains in creating, designing and producing different kinds of technological projects, such as virtual and augmented reality, videomapping and e-commerce, among others.

International experience: with Canterbury Christ Church University. An excellent opportunity to exchange knowledge and culture that will be become a reality in projects by international teams (Online International Learning), temporary stays (Short Global Experience Study / Field Trip), Erasmus+ programmes and the possibility of double degrees.

**Applied knowledge:** Advertising and Public Relations students organise the GoliADs UAO CEU Awards each year, a gala that has become a model for advertising agencies.

**Employability:** 97% of students find a job at the end of their studies, 11 percentage points above the Catalan universities average. (Job Placement Survey AQU 2014)

**Digital Communication Week:** lectures, meetings and debates on current affairs in new technologies with leading professionals of the digital revolution.

## What makes us different?

**Tradition:** we have more than 15 years of experience in training professionals in Psychology.

Intern Researcher Student: by creating this role, we allow students to carry out support tasks to research, be it in university teams or in healthcare centres, as it already happens in different Catalan hospitals. We publish two calls for this position each year to all degree and double degree students.

Therapeutic Unit for Psychological Assistance: located in the Sagrat Cor University Hospital, an institution that supports our project. This new Unit represents a clear example of shifting from university to the job market, as it allows UAO CEU to project its potential in the field of Psychology towards assistance and research, in constant synergy with teaching aspects. Students will actively take part in clinical sessions from the third year onwards.

**Methodology:** based on a humanistic approach of Psychology, it promotes an active and entrepreneurial attitude in students, as in the creation of the *Psykhé* Group. It implies reinforcement to early research activity and a valuable experience in regard to public speaking.

**Professionalisation:** more than **70%** of our Psychology degree faculty are active professionals specialised in the subject they teach.

## Personalised Economic Plan

Our University offers a Personalised Economic Plan, so that all the talented students have the opportunity to attend the UAO CEU.

Once you have made a reservation, the payment of the rest of the registration fee can be carried out in one of the following methods:

- Single payment. This method involves a 3% discount on the enrolment fees.
- **Instalment payment** of the enrolment fee in 5 instalments per year.
- Monthly payment. In 10 instalments through a special funding with 0% interest rate and without arrangement fees. It also comes with a 3% discount on tuition fees.
- Other payment methods. With Banco Santander, "la Caixa", Catalunya Caixa, BBVA and Banc Sabadell. This method also involves a 3% discount on the enrolment fees.
