Notifications will be sent by Friday, October 1, 2024.

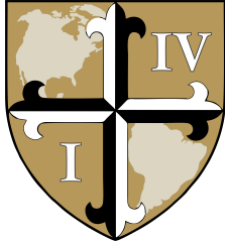
Submission of papers: until March 15, 2025.
